Addressed to Foreign Office telegram No. 32 of 19th June, repeated to Washington.

Press publishes this morning official bulletin stating that in view of the political situation of the country resulting from preparations abroad by Calderonists and Communists for a counter revolution with interior ramifications the Junta decided yesterday to suspend individual guarantees for a period of thirty days. It is also stated that on account of the appalling state of the country after eight years of administrative irregularities during the Calderon Communist régime the Junta will adopt energetic economic and social measures as the only means to save the country from disaster and misery.
