In fulfilment of the terms of decree No.179 of 21st September, 1948 which authorised the issue of National Reconstruction bonds

The President of the Founding Junta of the Second Republic

decrees

Article 1. The Finance Ministry will issue bonds on the Public Treasury for a total of Colones 30,000,000 in the form and for the values hereafter stated:-




- Article 2. These bonds will be called "Bonos de Reconstruccion Nacional -6%- 1948". They will bear facimile signatures of the Finance Minister and of the National Treasury. They will be dated November 30th, 1948, and will be void unless they bear the White Seal of the Republic.
- Article 3. They will expire on December 31st, 1958. Each bond will carry 40 coupons of three-monthly interest at 6% p.a. numbered 1/40. They will be signed by the Minister of Finance in facimile.
- Article 4. The amortisation of these bonds will be by threemonthly drawings, making use of the balance available after paying interests.
- Article 5. At the end of each three months the Bank of Costa Rica will proceed, with the intervention of the National Treasury, to execute the drawings of the bonds to be redeemed.
- Article 6. The first coupon will be payable on March 30th, 1949.
- Article 7. The bonds drawn will cease to earn interest on the day of their drawing.
- Article 8. The Bank of Costa Rica (Cashier of State) will retain daily and will accumulate in a special account the funds necessary for the service of these bonds.
- Article 9. The interest coupons of the bonds which at each drawing may not be cashed will be used to increase the fund for the service of the bonds.
